Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Auckland

Welcome to New Zealand! You will be met upon arrival and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Overnight Stay: Rydges Auckland Hotel

Day 2: Goldfields Railway – Rotorua - Maori Hangi (BD)

Journey to the top of Mt Eden, Auckland's highest extinct volcano, then head southward to Goldfields Railway. This vintage train will carry through the upper reaches of the stunning Karangahake Gorge. Continue on to Mt Maunganui before arriving in Rotorua the heartland of New Zealand's Maori culture. Tonight you will be entertained at a traditional Maori cultural performance followed by a Hangi feast.

Two Night Stay: Rydges Rotorua Hotel.

Day 3: Gondola Ride - Thermal Reserve (B)

This morning enjoy a Gondola ride up to Skyline Restaurant for breakfast. After breakfast continue on to the Agrodome for an entertaining show of sheep shearing and farm dog trials, then visit the bubbling mud pools and thermal geyser at the amazing Te Puia Thermal Valley and the Maori Arts and Craft Institute. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure.

Day 4: Overlander Train – Raurimu Spiral - Wellington (BD)

Journey to Taumaranui and board the Overlander for a magnificent afternoon's journey up the famous Raurimu Spiral, onto New Zealand's awesome volcanic plateau. After the 'drop', the route becomes green and lush again. See the dramatic white cliffs and viaducts of the Rangitekei River and closer to Wellington, view Kapiti Island and the exquisite coastline.

Overnight Stay: Mercure Hotel.

Day 5: Marlborough Sounds – TranzCoastal Train - Christchurch (BD)

Cruise through the picturesque Marlborough and Queen Charlotte Sounds to the south island. On arrival in Picton board the TranzCoastal train for one of New Zealand's most spectacular coastal journeys! Hugging the Kaikoura Coast, the train passes scenic vineyards, salt mountains and river valleys, a visual feast.

Overnight Stay: Grand Chancellor Hotel.

Day 6: TranzAlpine Rail - Franz Josef & Fox Glacier (BD)

Today's touring takes you for an unforgettable rail journey through the magnificent Southern Alps on the TranzAlpine. Disembark at Arthurs Pass and continue on to Hokitika to see skilled craftsmen carving Pounamu (Jade). Its then on to view the awesome Franz Josef Glacier. Opportunity to experience a scenic helicopter flight with snow landing (own expense and weather permitting).

Overnight Stay: Scenic Circle Fox Glacier Country Hotel

Day 7: Haast Valley – Arrowtown - Queenstown (BD)

Travel through sub-tropical rainforest to Haast Pass. Visit popular Arrowtown, a quaint and historic gold mining town. Continue on to picturesque Queenstown and your hotel overlooking beautiful Lake Wakatipu and the Remarkables mountain range.

Two Night Stay: Mercure Resort, Lakeview Rooms.

Day 8: Queenstown Free Day - TSS Earnslaw Cruise & Dinner (BD)

Today is free to explore at your own pace. Your Tour Director will assist with suggestions (optional activities at own expense). Late this afternoon cruise Lake Wakatipu on the vintage steamship TSS Earnslaw. Enjoy wine tasting and dinner at Walter Peak High Country Station followed by a short farm tour.

Day 9: Kingston Flyer - Milford Sound Cruise - Te Anau (BD)

Join the Kingston Flyer, New Zealand's fully restored famous vintage steam train, for magnificent views of Lake Wakatipu and the fascinating alpine desert. Rejoin the coach in Fairlight and travel to Te Anau, gateway to Fiordland National Park. This afternoon you will experience and unforgettable cruise on Milford Sound.

Overnight Stay: Luxmore Hotel.

Day 10: Taieri Gorge Rail Journey - Dunedin (BD)

Journey to Dunedin, a university city of Scottish heritage and New Zealand's oldest city. This afternoon join the Taieri Gorge for a scenic rail journey through Central Otago. *Opportunity to experience the warmth of the local people during a one night 'Home Stay'. Included in the tour at no extra cost. Must be pre-booked.*

Overnight Stay: Kingsgate Hotel.

Day 11: Moeraki Boulders - Omarama (BD)

This morning depart Dunedin for Omarama, en-route visit the intriguing Moeraki Boulders.

Overnight Stay: Heritage Gateway Hotel.

Day 12: Mt Cook National Park - Lake Tekapo - Christchurch (BD)

Pass picturesque Lake Pukaki, then stop and view Mount Cook (weather permitting). Continue on to visit Lake Tekapo and the Church of the Good Shepherd, and then on to Christchurch for a sightseeing tour. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner at your hotel.

Two Night Stay: Grand Chancellor Hotel.

Day 13: Christchurch Historic Tram (B)

Today is free to enjoy this beautiful city at your own pace on the Christchurch historic tram. This beautifully restored heritage tram follows an inner city route providing an entertaining and informative tour of the most interesting and historic city sights. Choose to hop on and off as you like to explore the city further.
